- (2) New graduate students, transfer students, and first-year undergraduates must first complete the registration procedures and pay the full tuition and fees (including computer fee, and student insurance fees) before they can apply for a refund after taking a leave of absence.
- (3) The date for calculating the leave of absence or withdrawal period shall be the day the student (or parent) officially submits the leave of absence or withdrawal application to the responsible office (department). A refund can only be processed after completing the leave procedure within seven days. If there are delays due to factors attributable to the student, the actual date of leaving school will be used as the calculation basis.
- (4) Students who take a leave of absence or withdraw should complete the refund process within ten days to ensure a prompt refund.
